

SeaPort NxG – Rolling Admissions I Announcement

SYNOPSIS

The Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) intends to issue a solicitation for the first Rolling Admissions to Seaport Next Generation (NxG). The Government anticipates releasing the Request for Proposal (RFP) second quarter fiscal year 2021. It is anticipated that the solicitation number will be N00178-21-R-7000.

The Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division, on behalf of the Naval Sea Systems Command and the Navy SYSCOM partners NAVAIR, NAVWAR, NAVFAC, NAVSUP, ONR and USMC, will conduct a competition to award Multiple Award Indefinite-Delivery/Indefinite-Quantity contracts (MAC IDIQ) to allow SeaPort-NxG MAC holders to compete for future task order awards in Seaport NxG.

The NAICS code for this procurement is 541330 and the revenue size standard for Small Business is \$38.5 Million.

Proposal submission and evaluation criteria for the Rolling Admissions RFP will be similar if not identical to the original SeaPort NxG solicitation (N00178-18-R-7000).

Oral proposals will not be conducted. Awards will be made on initial offers without discussions. The solicitation will be issued electronically via Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) at <http://fbo.gov> and interested parties must comply with that announcement. FBO is the single point of entry for posting of the synopsis and solicitations to the internet. Interested offerors should monitor the FBO page for the release of the solicitation, and any applicable amendments. Offerors must be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) in order to participate in this procurement at <https://www.sam.gov/portal/public/SAM/>.
